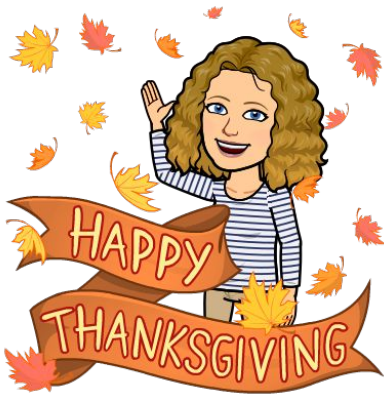

Learning Focus: Students will...

Math

- o Be able to recognize that in a multi-digit number, a digit in one place represents 10 times as much as it represents in the place to its right and 1/10 of what it represents in the place to its left.
- o Be able to add and subtract decimals.

Science

- o Be able to explain that light and sound are forms of energy that behave in predictable ways.

Language Arts

- o Be able to write opinion pieces on topics or texts, supporting a point of view with reasons and information.
- o Be able to describe how a narrator's or speaker's point of view and perspective influence how events are described.

Social Studies
